IN ADDITION TO THIS FORM, PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION:

- 1) **CURRICULUM VITAE:** This document should provide an overview of your academic, extracurricular, employment, and other experiences and activities. It should cover at least the period from high school education to the present.
- 2) **STATEMENT OF INTEREST:** Attach a letter (maximum 750 words) that addresses the following two points:
 - the basis for your interest in being a Saskatchewan Legislative Intern and what you hope to gain from the internship experience; and
 - a description of the skills and experience that you would bring to the internship – for this requirement you should describe an activity or project in which you participated as part of a group and the role you played in achieving its objectives.
- 3) **ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT:** Please provide your official university transcripts of grades. If the transcripts cannot be included with this application, please confirm whether they will be sent directly from the issuing university.
- 4) **STATEMENT OF NON-PARTISANSHIP:** Attach a statement which describes any participation within the past three years in activities supporting political parties and/or candidates for election at all levels of government within Canada. It is not necessary to identify your political affiliation. Please note that there are circumstances where such participation may be deemed to be partisan and therefore, may make the applicant unable to participate in the program. Any questions or concerns can be discussed with the Program’s director prior to submitting your application.

The information in these documents, as well as the letters of reference, will be used to short-list the approximately ten applicants who will be interviewed for internships.

E. Letters of Reference

Confidential appraisals are required from three people who know you well. Two of these people should be people under which you have studied. You should provide copies of the “Referee’s Confidential Appraisal Form” and request that they complete the form and send it to the Saskatchewan Legislative Internship Program’s director. The appraisal forms constitute part of your application and must be received by the director by the Program’s application deadline (March 31, 2010).
