



**Canadian Health Care Royal Commissions,
Commissions of Inquiry and Task Forces, 1878-2002:
A Selected Bibliography**

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Introduction

The seminal idea for this bibliography arises from the striking of the Royal Commission on the Future of Health Care in Canada. Since the first commission was struck, how many Royal Commissions have there been in Canada on health topics? Soon, it became necessary to expand this idea to include Commissions of Inquiry, since these are commissioned in the same fashion, i.e. under the relevant Public Inquiries Act, and also Task Forces, which are an intermediary type of study between a Royal Commission and a working group/advisory committee. Each of these types of inquiry is struck for a specific purpose, and is to produce a report or reports. Once these reports are issued, the study group is usually disbanded. There may also be included special committees and a very restricted few other types of studies, usually which arose from a target study, or which are follow-up studies.

The boundaries of the concept “Health Care” have been difficult to define. Lists below indicate which categories have been included and which excluded. As a rule, if a particular study mentioned any of the three subsets, “Commission of Inquiry”, “Royal Commission” or “Task Force”, it was considered for this project, until the inevitable exceptions started to arise. As a result, trade-offs have been necessary in selecting entries and inconsistencies will be found. Thus, although a study on accessibility to transportation for the frail elderly has been excluded (more social services, than a health focus, although this might be debatable), and although occupational health and safety studies are excluded, a submission to the Task Force on Electronic Commerce regarding Bill C-54 and the implication for privacy of medical information has been included.

It has been difficult to determine the relevance of certain categories and studies that may be excluded by one criterion but included by another, for example, inter-relations among rehabilitation (including occupational and physical therapy, acupuncture and chiroprody), occupational health and safety, workers’ compensation and accident/handicaps prevention. As the user will note, there are still plenty of studies included—more than 250 main entries, with many more reports subsumed under some of these main studies than others.

Often, studies are referred to by the chief author, in this case, the chairperson(s) or task force leader. Most of these reports have been examined to determine these names, but strangely, some chairs were not designated either in the letter of transmission, the list of personnel, or the appendices. Occasionally, they have appeared elsewhere in an executive summary or note of appreciation, but some studies simply do not designate a chair.

Selection Criteria

Generally, included here are the interim, final, summary reports, including executive summaries, and progress reports (except annual reports), and some discussion papers and background studies for the various studies, as these have been located. Submissions to federal and provincial Royal Commissions have been generally excluded from consideration in this bibliography, due to the vast numbers of these submissions before such inquiries. However, the health-related parts of some Royal Commissions, such as that on Aboriginal Peoples, have been included. The reason why only “some” discussion papers, etc. have been included is that the Library may only hold a few or even none of these reports, or they may not have been listed in the sources used to compile this bibliography.

It has occasionally been difficult to determine which report is the antecedent to that under consideration, but an attempt has been made to match all related reports.

Generally, all task forces have been considered for this list, both department- and minister-initiated, joint-jurisdictional, those of mixed origin, including hybrid governmental and non-governmental, and strictly non-governmental, such as those struck by associations.

For Saskatchewan, all studies related to the so-called “Thrust Committee” of the Department of Health have been included. Only some of these studies were designated as Task Forces.

Only public reports are listed here, and only free down-loadable PDF documents, where available, have been listed as Internet documents. Some Canadian Institute for Health Information (CIHI) publications that might have been considered for inclusion have been excluded, as a result, because they are not free.

What is included?

The following categories of studies have been included in this bibliography:

- *all mental health studies;*
- *drugs and drug abuse;*
- *specific illnesses;*
- *studies of health care facilities, including specific hospitals, and health regions, except their annual reports;*
- *health insurance;*
- *all medical personnel studies, including pay and benefits, labour relations, education and continuing training, staffing;*
- *medical specialities, such as cytology and radiation treatment, and branches of medicine, such as dentistry and surgery, and alternative medicine;*
- *rehabilitation, including occupational and physical therapy and chiropractice;*
- *medical costs of particular health problems, such as drunk driving;*
- *medical and health-care ethics;*
- *some consultation and discussion papers, policy papers, and feedback documents to these larger studies.*

What is excluded?

Excluded from this bibliography are the following studies and categories:

- *annual reports*;
- *automobile insurance*, but medical effects of traffic accidents are included;
- *conference proceeding and workshop reports*;
- *coroners inquiries*;
- *directories* of programs and services in specific areas or for specific populations;
- *draft legislation*, but committee interim and final reports on such matters are included;
- *human rights*;
- *mortality and other vital statistics compilations and studies*;
- *occupational health and safety*;
- *workers' compensation*;
- *specific industries*, such as the grain industry, and mining;
- *strictly-technical environmental health studies which exclude a health policy component*, such as lead levels in the blood of persons living near smelters or other factories producing such contaminants (however, two studies in New Brunswick on cancer and the environment, and human reproduction and environmental chemicals, are included);
- *individual submissions before Royal Commissions*, except for individual studies that were submitted within the context of a non-health-related larger study, and here, only as these could be identified;
- *water studies*.

Organization

Concerning commissions and task forces on general health themes, all documents emanating from the same study are grouped together in one place. Thus, a preliminary study, the final report, the executive summary, if available, and reactions to these recommendations are listed together.

Concerning general commissions and task forces subdivided into more specific themes, the reports have been broken up to be filed under a subject heading. (Quebec's Royal Commission from the 1960s has been kept together, since the individual final reports are available in the Library in English, but all the "Annexes", save two, are available here only in French).

All reports are listed in one place only.

Sections are organized alphabetically as follows:

- Federal Canadian studies;
- Provincial studies, alphabetically within province;
- Other studies.

The Legislative Library holds the vast majority of the reports listed. Those absent have been noted at the appropriate entry. Where the Library owns or has access to various formats for the same document, these are listed in the following order:

- Paper copy
- Microfiche copy
- Internet address, plus the date of access to confirm availability.
- SEE or SEE ALSO references, if any, have been entered at the appropriate points to lead the user to other possibly related studies. Related to this is the abbreviation "b", in lowercase that indicates a bullet, below that main entry; thus, "A25b4" indicates the 4th bullet entry for the entry A25.
