We have made an examination to determine whether the New Democratic Party Caucus complied with the provisions of the following directives of the Board of Internal Economy noted below. Compliance with the established criteria of the Directives is the responsibility of the Caucus. Our responsibility was to express an opinion on this compliance based on our audit.

Directive #7.3 Caucus Information Technology Resources
Directive #11 Grant to Office of the Leader of the Opposition
Directive #23 Caucus Accountability and Disclosure

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the New Democratic Party Caucus compiled with the criteria of the directives referred to above. Such an audit includes examining on a test basis evidence supporting compliance, and evaluating overall compliance with the criteria.

In our opinion, as at March 31, 2017, the New Democratic Party Caucus has complied, in all significant respects, with the criteria established by the directives.
