Based in the historic Legislative Building in beautiful Wascana Park, this role offers the chance to grow, evolve, and contribute to something bigger. The Legislative Assembly Service (LAS) is dedicated to enhancing parliamentary democracy by providing impartial, non-partisan support to the Legislative Assembly. Our mission is to foster a transparent, participatory democracy, with a team committed to supporting the institution of Parliament for the people of Saskatchewan.

\*The Legislative Assembly Service is evolving its IT structure to support long-term organizational needs. We are hiring one position — either an <u>IT/Server Analyst</u> or a <u>Security Analyst</u> - based on the strengths of the candidate pool. This role is essential in maintaining a stable, scalable, and high-performing infrastructure that underpins the work of Members and the Assembly.

Reporting to the Manager of Information Technology Services, the IT/Server Analyst is responsible for planning, deployment, operation and support of networks, servers, infrastructure, endpoints and applications that support the operations of the enterprise IT systems and data.

## What You'll Do:

- Design, implement, and maintain enterprise server and storage infrastructure (Windows, Linux, Hyper-V, Azure) to support secure and reliable service delivery.
- Monitor and optimize system performance, analyzing logs and diagnostics to prevent outages and ensure capacity meets organizational needs.
- Administer Microsoft 365 and Azure environments, including Azure AD, Exchange, conditional access policies, and group/security management.
- Apply patching, system updates, and infrastructure hardening across physical and cloud-based environments.
- Troubleshoot complex issues related to servers, virtualization, storage, and critical applications, escalating to vendors when required.
- Support and maintain specialized applications such as SharePoint, Legislative Tracker, and live streaming platforms to ensure seamless performance.
- Provide Tier 2/3 technical support and collaborate with the service desk team to resolve infrastructure-related client issues.
- Participate in disaster recovery planning and testing to ensure operational resilience and data integrity.
- Document infrastructure configurations, procedures, and resolutions to support operational continuity and team knowledge sharing.
- Collaborate with internal IT teams and external partners to coordinate system changes, upgrades, and service improvements.

## **What You Bring:**

- Bachelor's degree in computer science, information technology or related field, along with progressively responsible experience in IT service delivery across Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 support levels.
- Networking server operations (Microsoft Windows Server), virtualization (Hyper-V, VMware, and cloud platforms (Microsoft Azure).
