

## Legislative Page (on-site, Part-time, Term Position) Summary of Benefits

## Salary

The salary of the **Legislative Page** is **\$19.576** per hour.

This position receives benefits similar to public service employees.

Sick leave	Term employees earn and accumulate pro-rated sick leave credits based on their regular hours worked.	
Vacation Leave	Term employees earn 6.36% vacation pay on each cheque based on the number of regular hours worked and their years of service. (calculation of the vacation leave entitlement will consider eligible previous public service).	
Statutory Holidays	Term employees earn 5.4% statutory holiday pay on each cheque based on the number of regular hours worked.	
Other Benefits	Public Employees Pension Plan	<ul> <li>Employees must contribute 5% of gross salary</li> <li>Employer contributes 9%</li> </ul>
	Overtime	Paid at the rate of time and a half.
Hours of Work	The term of the employment will be over both the 2025 fall (mid-October to mid-December) and 2026 spring (early March to mid-May) sittings of the Assembly. Legislative Pages do not work in the period between mid-December to early March.  Monday to Wednesday  12:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.  Some overtime may be required each week, particularly when the Assembly is sitting on Monday and Tuesday evenings from 6:45 p.m. – 10:30 p.m.  Thursday  9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.	
Attire	A uniform is provided for wear while working in the Legislative Chamber. Casual business attire is required during non-Chamber hours.
